# $V_{\text {Red Kite }}$ Mobile 

## Instructions

## You will need:

- The 4 sheets printed onto thin card
- Body pages I and 2 on A4 card
- Wings pages I and 2 on A3 card
- Scissors
- Glue
- Clear tape
- Colouring pencils
- Fishing wire or thin string
- 2 sticks or dowel



## What to do:

- If you have access to a photo-copier, copy the sheets so they 2 body pages are back to back and the 2 wings pages are back to back. If not, just use page I of each.
- Decorate both sides of the body and wings - you can choose realistic or made up colours.
- Cut out the body and the wings (including the little slots).
- Fold down the tabs at the top of the wings and stick them onto the body, where the dotted box is.
- Slide the tail feathers into the slot and secure with a bit of tape.
- Attach 3 pieces of fishing wire/ thin string to the tail and both wings.
- Pull the 3 pieces of string up and attach each one to a dowel or thin stick above the body. This will be used to control the kite's movements.
- To make the kite soar through the air, hold the stick and tilt from side to side.
